## "I FELT NOTHING BUT LOVE, ACCEPTANCE, A SENSE THAT MAYBE I DO BELONG HERE."

Four years ago, my world came crashing down. My faith, as far as I was concerned, was non-existent. How could God let this happen? I am a good person, why am I being tested to this extreme? Life has been horrifying to me. The church I attended before had abandoned me, I could not look at myself or my family and friends I have left without feeling shame and guilt. The next four years I suffered from agoraphobia and did not leave the house under any circumstance. The depression, fear, emptiness, guilt, and disgust plagued me everyday. Then, one day in January, I had to leave my house to get medicine for my parents and I saw the sign for NLC on the side of the road. I pulled over and sat for a few minutes and began to cry. It seems that God did not forget me! It took about 20 minutes of sitting in my car to send an email asking about the church. I was so scared to send that email in fear of judgement, rejection, another person telling me I didn't deserve to live for the things I had done. 10 minutes later, my location pastor called me and as soon as I answered, my heart and stomach were in my throat. But as he spoke, I felt nothing but love, acceptance, a sense that maybe I do belong here. That someone does value me. NLC has changed my life and has brought light to a dark chapter. Now, I attend NLC every Sunday and am on a path of restoration, a chapter of ever-increasing Godfidence, of building love for myself and God. I will never be able to put into words how important and special NLC is!

Approximately a year and a half ago, we moved to Maine to be closer to our families. The hardest thing for me in leaving Washington State was leaving my home church, one that was our family for over 5 years. For the longest time, leaving Washington was not an option for me BECAUSE of my church home. However, I came to realize that God would be with me wherever we went and that he had different plans for us as a family. When we arrived in Maine, I tried many different churches and none seemed to fit and then I accidentally stumbled upon NLC on Facebook. Being a part of NLC has challenged me to step out of my comfort zone, has challenged me spiritually and has challenged me to be a part of something greater. NLC reminds me to keep my eyes focused on God through it all, good or bad.




### **NLC TEAMS**
